Lionel Dodd and Fares Boulos have determined that they will not stand for re-election at the Company's upcoming annual general meeting. Mr. Mossadiq S. Umedaly, Chairman of Xantrex, said, "The Board would like to thank Messrs. Dodd and Boulos for their past service to the Company." Mr. Dodd's decision is due to personal commitments. Mr. Boulos' decision is due to philosophical differences with the Board.

As a result of these decisions, the Board of Directors has fixed the size of the Board at 6 directors effective May 16, 2007.
